वूशु खिलाड़ी अंशिता पाण्डे एकलव्य अवार्ड से सम्मानित

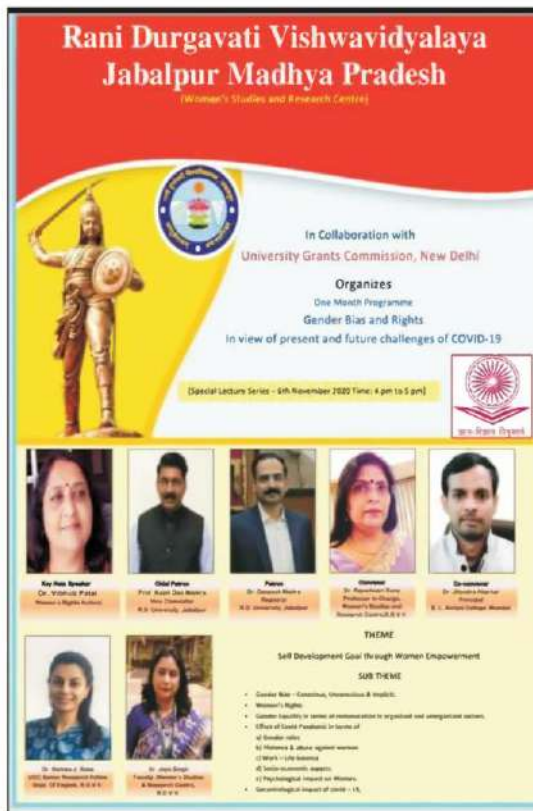
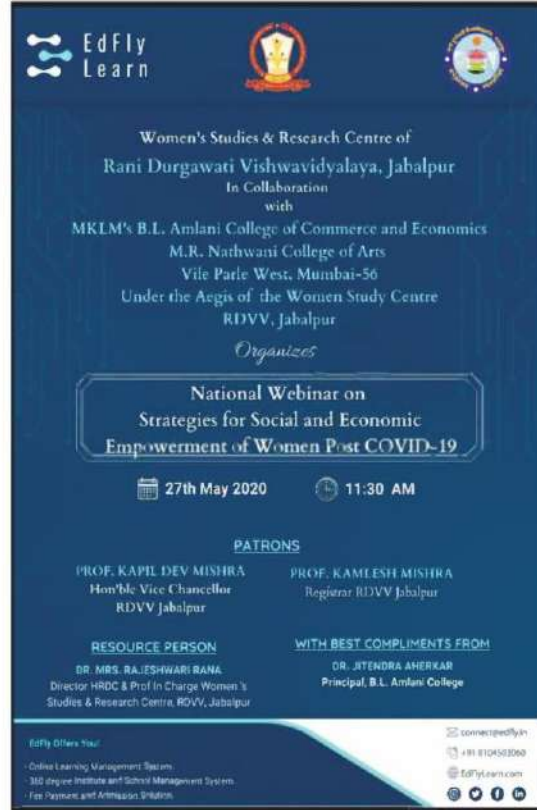

WSRC was established in 1988 by Rani Durgavati Vishwavidhlaya, Jabalpur. In tune with the UGC 12 plan guideline, the WSRC at RDVV was re-established on 1st April 2016 and has taken up developing interdisciplinary approaches, evolving theory, new strategies of pedagogy and curriculum to tackle the complex issues faced by women as a marginalized regiment. The Centre has adopted a multipronged approach to cater to women issues arising from diversity of caste, clan, gender, ethnicity, region, religions, work groups and so on. - To be constituted as a teaching cum research department, realizing that the growth of the discipline could only be achieved through the translation of research findings into the classrooms. The Centre seeks to develop various Women's Studies courses as well as teaching/learning material.
- To make a plan for introducing more certificate courses in future like Women Entrepreneurship Skill Development, Women Empowerment, Mushroom Cultivation for Self Employment, Office Management, Legal Awareness for Women, Stress Management and Personality Development.
- Emphasis will be given more on collaborative research.
