#### REMEDIAL COACHING SCHEME

Remedial Coaching Schemes for SC/ST/OBC UGC has facilitated several measures for the academic upliftment and further advancement of SC/ST/OBC students. The popular schemes are: Remedial Coaching; Coaching for NET/SLET etc; and Coaching for Competitive Exams for entry to services (UPSC, PSC, etc).

Rani Durgawati University being located in an area which has substantial number of students, who belong to the target group, holds ample opportunities to steer the objectives of the UGC through such schemes. These coaching schemes have been in operation for several years and have subsequently made efforts to fill the gap between the actual level of knowledge and desired level of knowledge amongst these students. The central focus is to develop a good amount of confidence among the students with regards to their education and choices leading to their employment.

The class room teaching, though primary, is regularly supplemented by group discussions and student initiative activities, thereby leading to the improvement in their presentation skills. Presentation ability not only enhances the leadership qualities but also assists in their overall personality development. Presently subjects like Economics, History, Political Science, Sanskrit, and Sociology are sought after by these students.

The scheme was felicitated by the expertise of senior faculty members of the university. In a nutshell, the best available resources were invited to share their experiences with the beneficiaries of the schemes. To overcome the language barrier an appropriate arrangement and installation needs to be the primary requirement. Further, the students need counselling on issues pertaining to education, employment, hobbies, and contemporary social and ethical issues.

#### The Vision of Remedial Coaching in Rani Durgawati University:

1. Improving academic skills and linguistic proficiency of the students of slow learners and SC/ST/OBC etc students.

- 2. Raising their level of comprehension of basic subjects to provide a stronger foundation for further academic work.
- 3. Strengthening their knowledge, skills and attitudes in such subjects, where quantitative and qualitative techniques and laboratory activities are involved so that proper guidance and training provided under the programme may enable the students to cope up to the level necessary for pursuing higher studies efficiently.

### The Mission of Remedial Coaching in Rani Durgawati University:

- 1. The basic objective of the coaching centre is to prepare students belonging to SC / ST/ OBC (non-creamy layer) and Minority communities to get gainful employment in Group 'A', 'B' or 'C' State services or equivalent positions in the private sector.
- 2. The goal of coaching under the scheme is to orient students for particular examinations conducted for selection to services, such as the:-
  - (a) IAS,
  - (b) State Public Services,
  - (c) Bank recruitment, etc.

The Coaching to be focused, taking into consideration the specific requirements of a particular competitive examination.

- 1. Aim to extend knowledge, stimulate learning and promote understanding for the upliftment as well as welfare of the marginalized populations in general.
- 2. To select area of their difficulties and arrange programs to remove these difficulties.
- 3. To conduct classes of selected subject by the faculties of the respective department
- 4. To minimize drop out ratio.
- 5. To strive for overall development of students.
- 6. To fulfill their academic requirements.
- 7. To focus on students of the rural/tribal region who are relatively in soft skills.

#### Outcome:

Through this effort of the faculty, the slow learners are highly benefitted and are able to understand their lessons in a better way. Remedial teaching is a kind of follow up and it is done after an initial phase of teaching and evaluation. Remedial teaching as a part of curriculum is being done for the sake of slow learners with the aim of improving their understanding ability through easy and simple language exercises. Study materials are specially prepared for them for easier understanding. There was marked improvement in the level of achievement after the rigorous remedial teaching at regular intervals. Weekly two classes were held between 3:10 and 4:00 pm.
